

Pulmonary Function Testing (PFT)

- A pulmonary function test or “breathing test” is done to test your lung function.
- Depending on the test that your doctor ordered, the test will take between 30 minutes to an hour.
- Do not drink caffeinated drinks four hours before the test and do not smoke the day of the test.
- Do not use a bronchodilator or inhaler four hours before the test; we may be administering a bronchodilator as part of the test.
- Wear loose, comfortable clothing. No tight belts or neckties.
- Do not eat a large heavy meal before your test.
- Please no perfumes or scented lotions.
- If you use oxygen you will be asked to remove it before the test.
